How rare is this vase shape?

One of the Group's Christmas cards featured a vase shape which might actually deserve the description "rare". And we don't think many folks would guess which one.

It's the card featuring "I saw three ships come sailing in" and the vase is a Delphic Sunset decoration. 7332 on ???

But what shape? The base numbers aren't very helpful. It

looks like 77bird! And it is not any of 770 to 779 (see 1920s Vase listing on the Group website).

Only two examples of this shape are currently known to us. The other



one is 8103 pattern number (Roself,) both vases are 17cm high:

That distinguishes it from the one it's most likely to be confused with - the 784 shape at 14cm high. Also pattern number 8103
