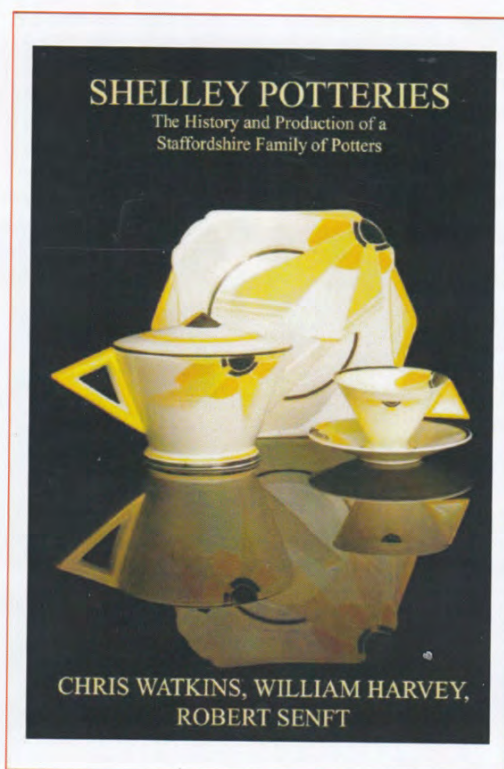

Book Review – Shelley Potteries – fourth edition.

This book essentially needs no introduction to most Shelley Group members, having long been the “bible” for Shelley collectors interested in the history of the pottery, its products, the family of owners and the key staff, throughout its history. Although it was written 35 years ago, it was thoroughly researched and accurately written and is as valuable to Shelley enthusiasts now, as it was when first published. The difference in this edition is that it is now re-issued as an electronic book, (e-book) In September 2015 Chris Watkins gave us his updated colour version of the 1899 *Artist* magazine article on the Wileman products of that time. He has now re-issued the *Shelley Potteries* book, of which he was co-author with William Harvey Pettit and Robert Senft. It incorporates some minor amendments to the original text and many colour illustrations to replace the original monochromes.
